


Many do not apply to MFTs




relative frequencies of personal pronouns, adverbs, adjectives, sentence relatives, past participles, etc.

Malicious purpose

Letter collected from the FBI Vault addressed to Senator Helms - Dimension 4 score = 15.79

Dear Senator Helms,

or to whoever reads this letter first.

Inform everyone who are national senators and representatives and say or show this letter amonge them.

A desolation has been $\underline{\text{decreed}}$ upon the nation and upon those in the nation. $\underline{\text{If}}$ I do not receive \$25,000 dollars in cashiers checks at \$25 each these things $\underline{\text{shall}}$ take place.

The two wings of the capital building <u>shall</u> crumble to the ground. It <u>will</u> happen in this manner.





Research questions

- How do English MFTs compare to other important registers of the English language?
 - MFTs are situated in between personal and professional letters. They are a particular type of persuasive professional letters
- Which situational parameters are the most useful to describe MFTs and to predict some of the variation in their language?
 - Malicious purpose, Addressee type, Direction of harm
- Is it possible to establish an initial categorisation of MFTs based on their linguistic features?
 - Three linguistic dimensions separate MFTs: D1, D2, and D4









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
